



BENEFICIARY #1

Anna Foundation

MISSION STATEMENT: To assist disadvantaged schools and communities by providing academic, social and environmental support and equipping children with skills for lifelong learning. We recognise each child as unique and special and aim to support the holistic development of the child.

SERVICES OFFERED: Education (literacy, numeracy, remedial and reading programmes), physical development (sports) and the teaching of life skills through drama games. We also train rural women to implement our programmes (skills development).



“Our focus this year has turned to helping all the children in our programme LEARN TO READ WITH MEANING. The ability to read is central to the ability to learn and therefore a prerequisite to progress successfully through the education system. Irrespective of the subject, the South African curriculum assumes that children have learned how to read by the end of Grade 3, an assumption that is not supported by the evidence. Most South African children are not acquiring the most basic reading skills (in any language), and as such remain on the periphery of the learning process and never fully access the curriculum despite being promoted to higher grades. Our experience has shown that schools are not placing enough emphasis on this central goal, and as such we have made this our priority in all of our after school projects in 2016.”



BENEFICIARY #2

The Click Foundation



MISSION STATEMENT: To innovate and test non-conventional, technology based solutions that have the potential to scale and meaningfully impact education for individuals.

SERVICES OFFERED: Online foundation phase literacy programme. Implementation, training and management of the programme in primary schools.

It lifts school principal Grantham Jansen's heart to see youngsters running down the school passage to the computer lab when it's time for their Reading Eggs class. Established in 2012, The Click Foundation runs this online phonetics-based English literacy programme at Vlotenburg Primary School near Stellenbosch. Mr Jansen enthuses about the positive impact the programme has on his pupils, who start the programme at the end of Grade R to promote their English reading, writing and speaking skills. The youngsters pick up computer literacy immediately: 'These Grade Rs may come from rural, disadvantaged backgrounds but they know what to do!' he laughs. 'They find the English so exciting. It's very encouraging: you see them with their headphones on, and when they get something right on the computer, their faces light up.' The discipline learnt in the computer room, with its strict code of conduct overseen by two facilitators, is an equally valuable part of the children's education. 'Reading Eggs is one of the best support materials a school can have. It's a beautiful thing as it's gentle on the child. I get excited when I see kids having fun and learning at the same time,' he says. Parents love it too as it means their children are keen to go to school. Alichia Meyer, a Grade 2 pupil whose English is flourishing, says, 'What I like to do on Reading Eggs is when I must catch the letters to move to the next level. I like building on the walls with words like "the" and building another word. My English is much better. I can read, write and speak it very well!'



Sand Tray Therapy used by Community Keepers' trained therapists. This powerful therapeutic method provides a "free and protected" space where children create a concrete manifestation from their imagination using sand and miniature objects.

Eight female grade 10 learners from Makupula Secondary (Kayamandi) and 11 learners from Cloetesville High School are enrolled in the 18 month Code4CT coding program. The girls are now able to code in HTML, JAVA script and CSS. In 2017 they will continue with the program and can choose to specialize in front- or back-end coding. ... We want to position Makupula Secondary as a model of a low resource school and community that have taken on digital-based teaching, learning and collaboration.



MISSION STATEMENT: The Kusasa Project educational programme aims to provide a quality Pre-school and Foundation Phase education to disadvantaged children in the Franschhoek Valley of the Western Cape, South Africa. In addition, we seek to enable bright scholars to attend higher-functioning secondary schools and receive after-school academic and life skills support through our programme.

SERVICES OFFERED: Early Childhood Development, Scholarship Programme, Feeding Scheme.

Love 2 Give Skills Academy BENEFICIARY #10



MISSION STATEMENT: To offer sustainable livelihoods and enterprise development; to mentor families and support them in areas such as urban agriculture, crafts, community-based business and finding jobs in the formal sector. Our monthly food parcel is a supportive intervention for six months, while we assist critically poor mothers in developing the necessary skills to become financially self-sufficient. Many of those we support are seasonal workers in the wine industry with only a few months of reliable income every year.

SERVICES OFFERED: Sustainable Livelihood development in Kayamandi.

"Although malnutrition can never be eradicated, Love2Give has made important strides in reducing the levels of malnutrition in the children of Kayamandi. The number of malnourished children are now the lowest they have ever been, less than 1%. To put this into context, when we started in 2005, children were consuming chalk to stave off hunger and more than 75% of the Primary School children were malnourished."

BENEFICIARY #11

The Lunchbox Fund

MISSION STATEMENT: The Lunchbox Fund is a Non-Profit Organisation that focuses on fostering education via nutrition by providing a daily meal for orphaned and at-risk school children in townships and rural areas of South Africa.

SERVICES OFFERED: Primary Focus: Education Based Nutrition Programs which The Lunchbox Fund has pioneered in Early Childhood Development Centres. The Fund also provides Nutrition Programs to After-School Assistance organisations and Learner Skills Development Programs. Supplementary lunch programmes are given in government schools where the student numbers have outstripped gazetted feeding numbers, as well as to Quintile 4/5 Schools who do not benefit from the government supplied National School Nutrition Programme. The Fund's Secondary Focus is Female Empowerment through employment.



In schools with over 80 children, we hire previously unemployed women, preferably mothers or grandmothers from the community to prepare and serve the food. Our fieldworkers are also drawn from the local community. Fieldworkers conduct school evaluations and follow-up monitoring visits.

BENEFICIARY #12

Maranatha Trust

MISSION STATEMENT: Sustainable community development through education.

SERVICES OFFERED: Early Childhood Development centre for farmworkers' children in the Swartland.



When Maranatha Trust established Onse Skool in an old cellar in rural Aprilskloof near Malmesbury in 2013, the pre-school began with 14 children from the surrounding grape farms. Informal childminders, often unemployed, had exposed many children to abuse, and positive change was needed. It came. Now there are fifty children at the school who believe that they are valuable and loved. They are agents of change in their families and encourage a sense of responsibility in their community. During 2016 the pre-schoolers were taken on outings and the school started a vegetable garden where the children harvested potatoes, carrots and spinach. One of 2016's most touching events was the games evening, where it was clear some parents played with their children for the first time. Onse Skool's staff members, all previously unemployed and untrained as educators, have been empowered beyond all initial expectations. More unemployed women are being trained to staff an aftercare facility, opening at the local primary school in 2017.

MISSION STATEMENT: A leading NPO in the field of holistic community development within rural farm worker communities, with a core focus on education.

SERVICES OFFERED: Education, Health, Nutrition, Community Development, Social Protection Programmes.

Today Tashwell Baartman, 26, is an award-winning firefighter with a ready smile. Yet he might have become a school drop-out had he not encountered The Pebbles Project, which supplies crèches and after-school care to needy Winelands farm communities. From Grade 10, Tashwell attended a Pebbles After School Club on the Stellenbosch farm on which he grew up: 'I'd do my homework there every afternoon; the staff would help us. And we'd go on outings with them. It was lekker,' he recalls. An outing to the Stellenbosch Municipality Fire Department became a life-changing event. 'I saw this was a great job – dangerous; I liked it!' he laughs. 'You had to be mentally and physically fit, and you needed to have matric, maths and a driver's licence. I made it my goal to be a firefighter. I was motivated and did my homework every day.' After passing matric, Tashwell was employed by his Pebbles After School Club as a sports coach for a year while he began volunteering as a firefighter at Stellenbosch Municipality. After five years he was made a permanent staff member, and this year proved his professional mettle by coming second in his age category in the national Toughest Firefighter Alive competition. To the children on the farm, Tashwell has superhero status. 'Most of the youth give up school, but now there are six who've finished matric. They've seen me with my job at the fire department, earning money,' he says. 'I tell them, "You must never give up. I never did, and I was glad when I was made a permanent employee. Don't think that because you live on a farm you can't get a job. If you get an opportunity, grab it.'



BENEFICIARY #16

Pinotage Youth Development Academy (PYDA)

MISSION STATEMENT: "Launching talent to be the difference". The goal is to develop talented, previously disadvantaged 18-25 year olds through personal development and industry-specific vocational training so that they are able to launch careers that will enable them to sustain their families and contribute to change in their communities.

SERVICES OFFERED: The curriculum consists of 40% wine industry-specific vocational training, 40% personal development and 20% practical work placements. This unique programme follows the agricultural season and is not based on a traditional academic year. The curriculum is fully integrated across the value-chain and combines technical skills with in-programme workplace practicals and, critically, personal life skills development. Strict workplace policies and procedures during the programme enable graduates to enjoy accelerated integration into the world of employment. An essential aspect is psycho-social support which includes coaching and mentoring.



BENEFICIARY #17

South African Sommeliers Association (SASA)

MISSION STATEMENT: SASA promotes, regulates and orchestrates the South African Sommelier's Profession. SASA is a registered non-profit organization which provides training and mentorship to guarantee the continuous development of professional service standards of the highest level in South Africa.

SERVICES OFFERED: Education has been identified as a key priority from the onset, and SASA has created accredited sommelier training programmes with international accreditation.



"We have identified a large gap in the profession locally between experienced, internationally trained sommeliers and the broad junior hospitality and restaurant staff that has enthusiasm and talent, but lack the stepping stone of local sommelier qualification and training. Regular feedback from foreign visitors is that our restaurants are world-class, but wine service is often lagging behind. We believe that this is a direct result of a lack of properly trained and qualified staff."

BENEFICIARY #18

Wine Training South Africa

MISSION STATEMENT: To be the leading wine educational body with the focus on the cellar worker in the South African wine industry. Empowerment through Knowledge.

SERVICES OFFERED: Cellar Staff Education (Adult Education) Short Courses as well as Accredited Programmes.



From a very humble beginning 29 years ago where a group of 50 Cellar Workers attended a morning workshop, the program grew in leaps and bounds to bring not only training for Cellar Assistants, but to have an impact on the personal growth of individuals.

For Wine Cellars, the training effectively improves the workforce by honouring their knowledge, skills and competencies required for the developing individual.

During 2016 a total of 609 learners attended WTSA Short Courses. Courses are presented at Elsenburg, Graham & Rhona Beck Skills Centre in Robertson, Namaqua Winery in Olifants River Region and Orange River Winery.

We have realised that there is a tremendous problem with the basic foundation of mathematical literacy with a large percentage of our learners. Wine Training SA is registered with the IEB (Independent Education Board of SA) as the only Training Provider in the Western Cape. This affiliation allows Wine Training SA to teach Foundational Skills (Mathematics and Communication) to enrol learners for their Independent Examination at IEB. Successful Completion of this qualification opens the door to any further Accredited Education and the Quality Control for Trades and Occupations.

91 tests were written during 2016 at Elsenburg, Robertson, Worcester and Vredendal. Only 26% of candidates were competent (above 50%). Of this 26%, one candidate achieved a mark above 80%, two candidates achieved marks above 70%, the rest scored between 50 and 59%. 19% were in the 40 – 49% bracket, and 55% scored below 40%.

During 2016, 13 Learners attended the Induction Programmes offered in Robertson and Elsenburg. Five Learners completed the Programme as part of the National Certificate and two completed the Skills Programme. We also trained basic workplace specific (unaccredited) Maths to all 380 participants of our Short Courses (SKOP) during 2016.

Although this is a small start, we believe that the need for excellence in Mathematical Tuition is enormous, and with this project we not only want to live a dream, but live our Vision of Empowerment through Training.

SPARK Lyndoch School @ The Sustainability Institute
Principal: Mr Sivuyile Poro

When the Lyndoch Primary School was set to close on the outskirts of Stellenbosch in 2015 a number of organisations and funders stepped in to ensure that the children of the surrounding wine farms would have access to world-class education, care facilities and nutrition.

The Cape Wine Auction Trust together with the University of Stellenbosch Sustainability Institute and SPARK School has created an outstanding success story in the short span of only one year. The new SPARK School has seen Literacy improving by 55% and Maths by 30% across all grades.

The Lyndoch SPARK School is a living example of the Cape Wine Auction Trust's unique collaborative model of giving, where the Trust not only invests in what happens in the classroom but also alleviates some of the barriers to education. In addition to the sponsored tuition, the Lunch Box Fund provides nutritious meals and snacks, the Anna Foundation manages an after-school club, Community Keepers social workers and psychologists are on-site offering trauma counselling and mental health support, and the Click Foundation offers full-time access to computers and literacy software.

The SPARK School model offers a revolutionary methodology for primary school children in Africa with an individualised learning approach which combines teacher-led and computer instruction to track and improve children's progress.

Wendy owns De Morgenzon wine estate outside Stellenbosch. She was a director of Liberty Investors Limited, Deputy Chairman of Women's Investment Portfolio Limited (Wiphold) and Deputy Chairman of the Connection Group Limited. She remains a trustee of The Tribune Trust and a director of Sphere Holdings Limited. Her philanthropic involvement includes her being a director of the Wits Donald Gordon Medical Centre, as well as a trustee of The Donald Gordon Foundation. Wendy is also a member of the Global Philanthropists' Circle (GPC) and a director of the Southern African board of the Synergos Institute. She serves on Harvard University's Presidential Advisory Board and is a member of Harvard University's Women's Leadership Board. She is a member of the International Women's Forum (IWF) and of Women Moving Millions. She was honoured as one of the Leading Woman Entrepreneurs of the World in 2006 and received both the Forbes Woman Africa Business Woman of the Year and the Forbes Woman Africa Woman of the Year awards in 2015.



Paul Clüver

Paul studied B.Sc. Horticulture and Economics at the University of Stellenbosch upon completion of which he started working in the family business, heading one of the fruit production units. He continued studying, first Senior Business Management at the Graduates School of Business and later Masters in Philosophy in Value and Policy Studies at the University of Stellenbosch, while working as production manager, financial manager and eventually general manager. As general manager Paul and his team has helped establish De Rust Estate as a multifaceted agricultural business being one of the leading apple and pear growers in South Africa, one of the country's premium wine producers and one of the top Hereford studs while leading the way in sustainable farming and conservation. De Rust Estate is a BWI champion and has won the Nedbank Green Award for Best Practice as well as being a founding member of Thandi which is one of the first BEE farms in South Africa and is widely seen as one of the most successful projects in the industry. Thandi also became the first Fairtrade wine brand in the world. Paul currently serves on the following boards of directors and trusts: De Rust Estate home of "Paul Clüver Wines", Clüver & Jack (Pty) Ltd, Kromco (Pty) Ltd, Lebanon Fruit Farm Trust, Lebanon Community Trust, Cape Wine Auction Trust, South African Apple and Pear Producers' Association (SAAPPA) and the International Riesling Foundation.



Ken Kinsey-Quick

Ken has been involved in the global financial markets for over 20 years both in Paris and London. His particular expertise is in the hedge fund industry. Prior to moving back to SA in 2010, he was a partner at Thames River Capital for over ten years which was subsequently sold to London listed F&C. During his time in the UK, Ken was a big supporter of the ARK charity and raised money for them by hiking to the South Pole. On moving back to SA he has set up his own business, Diamond Capital Management, investing globally. Ken is also a Trustee of Bridge House School. He has a B.Com (UCT) and holds both the CFA and CAIA charters.

Raymond is co-founder and non-executive chairman of Black Elephant Vintners ("BEV"), an artisanal premium wine producer, in Franschhoek. 
Mike Ratcliffe

terms & conditions of sale

A. DEFINITIONS:

1. In these conditions of business, headnotes are for convenience only and shall not be used in their interpretation, any expression which denotes any gender shall include the other gender, any expression which denotes the singular shall include the plural (and vice versa), any expression which denotes a natural person shall include a juristic person (and vice versa) and the following terms shall have the following meanings:
 - i. "auction" means any private treaty or auction sale at which a lot is offered for sale
 - ii. "The CWA" means The Afrasia Bank Cape Wine Auction
 - iii. "auctioneer" means the representative of The CWA conducting an auction;
 - iv. "bidder" means any person making, attempting or considering to make a bid or offer to buy a lot at an auction, or private treaty sale;
 - v. "Buyer" means the bidder who makes the bid or offer for any lot that is finally accepted by the auctioneer (after determination by the auctioneer of any dispute that may exist in respect thereof) at a sale of that lot, and (where the Buyer is an agent acting for a principal), the Buyer and the Buyer's principal jointly and severally;
 - vi. "Buyer's premium" means the premium payable (if applicable) by the Buyer of a lot to The CWA on the sale of that lot, calculated on the hammer price of that lot at the relevant current rates;
 - vii. "catalogue" means any advertisement, brochure, estimate, price-list, condition report and other publication (in whatever medium, electronically or otherwise) published by The CWA in respect of any auction;
 - viii. "current rates" means The CWA's current rates of commission, premiums and other amounts payable to The CWA for the time being, together with VAT thereon (if any), all as published by The CWA (whether in a catalogue or otherwise) or as agreed between a prospective Buyer or Auctioneer (as the case may be) and The CWA;
 - ix. a "deliberate forgery" means an imitation made with the intention of deceiving as to authorship, origin, date, age, period, culture or source, which is not shown to be such in the description in the catalogue and which at the date of the sale had a value materially less than it would have had if it had been in accordance with that description and includes any misrepresentation made with intention of deceiving as to authorship, origin, date, age, period, culture or source;

 - xv. "recoverable expenses" includes all fees, taxes (including VAT if applicable), charges, and expenses incurred by The CWA in relation to any lot that The CWA is entitled to recover from a Buyer or Seller;
 - xvi. "reserve" means the confidential minimum hammer price (if any) at which a lot may be sold at an auction as agreed between the Buyer of that lot and The CWA in writing;
 - xvii. "sale proceeds" means the amount due to The CWA by the Buyer of a lot in respect of the sale of that lot, made up of the hammer price of the lot, less the applicable Auctioneer's commission (if applicable) for that lot, less all recoverable expenses for which the Seller is liable in respect of that lot and any other amounts due to The CWA by the Buyer in whatever capacity and howsoever arising (if applicable);
 - xviii. "sale" means the sale of any lot at an auction, whether done by private treaty or auction sale, and "sell" and "sold" shall have corresponding meanings;
 - xix. "Seller" means the person named as the Seller of any lot, being The CWA offers the lot for sale;
 - xx. "Auctioneer's commission" means the commission payable by the Buyer to The CWA on the sale of a lot that is calculated on the hammer price of that lot at the relevant current rate (if applicable);
 - xxi. "VAT" means value added tax levied in terms of the Value Added Tax Act, 1991.

B. GENERAL TERMS AND RULES OF AUCTION

The provisions of section 45 reads as follows:

1. Auctions

In this section, "auction" includes a sale in execution of or pursuant to a court order, to the extent that the order contemplates that the sale is to be conducted by an auction.

- i. When goods are put up for sale by auction in lots, each lot is, unless there is evidence to the contrary, regarded to be the subject of a separate transaction.

- ii. A sale by auction is complete when the auctioneer announces its completion by the fall of the hammer, or in any other customary manner, and until that announcement is made, a bid may be retracted.
 - iii. Notice must be given in advance that a sale by auction is subject to:
 - i. A reserved or upset price; or
 - ii. A right to bid by or on behalf of the owner, in which case the owner or auctioneer, or any one person on behalf of the owner or auctioneer, as the case may be, may bid at the auction.
 - iv. Unless notice is given in advance that a sale by auction is subject to a right to bid by or on behalf of the owner or auctioneer:
 - i. The auctioneer must not bid or employ any person to bid at the sale;
 - ii. The auctioneer must not knowingly accept any bid from a person contemplated in paragraph A.1.5 (a); and
 - iii. The consumer may approach a court to declare the transaction fraudulent, if this subsection has been violated.
 - v. The Minister may prescribe requirements to be complied with by an auctioneer, or different categories of auctioneer, in respect of:
 - i. The conduct of an auction;
 - ii. The records to be maintained with respect to property placed for auction; and
 - iii. The sale of any such property by auction.
2. The rules of the auction are those promulgated in terms of the Regulations promulgated by the Minister of Trade and Industry dated 23 November 2010 under Government Gazette No. 33818 on 1 April 2011 and any subsequent amendment and/or variation to the rules and these terms.
 3. The auctioneer is the agent for the CWA.
 4. These conditions of Purchase, as amended by addenda or oral announcements during the sale, constitute the entire terms and conditions of seller with respect to the sale and purchase of auction lots listed herein. By bidding, the bidder agrees to be bound by these Conditions of Purchase.
 5. Seller does not warrant or represent, expressly denies responsibility for, and in no event shall be liable for, the accuracy of the description of the wines (or other items) offered, or the correctness of the catalogue, including, but not limited to: the origin, rarity, age, genuineness, quantity, aging potential, present and future quality or condition of wines offered.
 6. All bids are per lot as announced by the auctioneer, listed in the catalogue.
 7. All statements by seller are merely statements of opinion and are not to be relied upon by prospective purchasers as warranties or representations of fact, and prospective bidders, by so bidding, acknowledge that they have inspected the wines to their satisfaction and bid only as a result of their own inspection and opinion. All wine is sold on strictly a "Voetstoots" basis.
 8. Auctioneer may, at any time prior to the close of any auction (or fall of the gavel in a live auction), withdraw the lot from sale.

 - ii. the only method of establishing at the date of publication of the catalogue that the lot was a deliberate forgery was by means of a scientific process not generally accepted for use until after publication of the catalogue, or by a process which was unreasonably expensive or impractical;
 - iii. Buyer's claiming under this condition will be limited to any amount paid in respect of the lot and will not extend to any loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered or expense incurred by him/her;
 - iv. the benefit of this condition will not be assignable and will rest solely and exclusively in the Buyer who, for the purpose of this condition, will be and only be the person to whom the original invoice is made out by The CWA in respect of the lot sold. The CWA will have the sole, exclusive and absolute right, at its discretion to refuse admission to any person to its premises or any other premises at which such auction is to be conducted.
 14. The CWA has the sole and absolute discretion without having to give any reasons therefore, to refuse any bid, withdraw or reoffer lots for auction (including after the fall of the hammer, cancel any sale if the Auctioneer

and/or The CWA believes that there may be an error or dispute of any nature whatsoever, and shall have the right, as it deems fit, to divide any lot, to combine any two or more lots, or to put up any lot for auction again. Any notice required to be given in connection with this agreement:

- i. if given by The CWA, shall be delivered by hand, or sent by registered post; or by email, provided such address is given in which event such address shall constitute the domicilium et citandi et executandi of the person to whom notice must be given. Notice shall be deemed to have been received by the person who is required to receive such notice, whether given personally or to a third party or any other manner as envisaged by this clause:
 - i. on the date of delivery if delivered by hand or email;
 - ii. on the seventh (7th) day from the date of posting, including the date of posting, if posted by prepaid registered post from within the Republic of South Africa, which postage shall be deemed to have been sent on receipt of the post office of proof of posting.

15. If required by The CWA, such written notification must be given to The CWA at its email address as published in the brochure, alternatively The CWA's published address and/or telephone number.

16. The Seller submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the South African courts.

17. The Buyer and/or Seller, as the case may be, hereby pledges the goods either sold and/or bought as security to The CWA for amounts which are owing to it.

18. No variation, alteration, consensual termination, representation, condition, term or warranty, relaxation or waiver or release by The CWA, or estoppel against The CWA, or the suspension by The CWA, in respect of these terms and conditions of business, or any part thereof, shall be of any force or effect unless reduced to writing and signed by The CWA and the Buyer.

19. The Buyer shall be responsible for the payment of The CWA's legal costs, calculated on the scale as between attorney and client, incurred by The CWA in enforcing any of its rights of its principal whether such rights are exercised by way of legal proceedings or not.

20. Notwithstanding the nature or amount of the claim by The CWA, The CWA and the Buyer hereby consent to the jurisdiction of the Magistrate's Court otherwise having jurisdiction; this consent is without prejudice to the right of The CWA to institute proceedings and to obtain judgment or any order in the High Court of competent jurisdiction, The CWA nevertheless still being entitled to claim on the High Court scale of costs and expenses, all as set out in this agreement.

C. TERMS RELATING TO BUYERS OF GOODS AT AN AUCTION OR BY PRIVATE TREATY

1. Buyer's Registration

- i. Buyer bidders must prior to the commencement of an auction register his/her identity on The CWA's Buyer's card and such

registration must with the necessary changes meet the requirements of Chapter 1 of the regulations in terms of the Financial Intelligence Centre Act, 2011, published in Notice No. R. 1595 in Gazette No. 24176 of 20 December 2002, in respect of establishment and verification of identity, and sign that entry.

2. Auction Bids

- i. The goods (lots) sold shall be to the highest bidder whether the sum bid be equivalent to the real value or not. Where the sale is announced to be with reserve, the goods shall be sold to the highest bidder either on or in excess of the reserve price.
- ii. No person shall, at any bid, advance less than the amount fixed for that purpose by the Auctioneer. Bids can be retracted before the fall of the hammer but the Auctioneer may refuse any bid.
- iii. Should there be a dispute as to the highest bid, even after the fall of the hammer the auctioneer shall in his sole and absolute discretion, determine which bid shall be accepted and The CWA and/or the Auctioneer shall be absolved of any liability of any nature whatsoever in regard thereto. In the event of a dispute the Auctioneer may determine the dispute in his absolute discretion, or the property may, at the Auctioneer's option, either be put up again at the least undisputed bid, or be withdrawn.

3. Absentee Bids

- i. Upon request, The CWA shall execute absentee bids on behalf of intending Buyers. Absentee bids are a service provided by The CWA for the Buyers benefit and The CWA cannot be held responsible for errors or omissions with respect to the bidding process. Lots will be bought as cheaply as is allowed by other bids placed and the Seller reserves. In the event of identical bids, the earliest will take precedence. When absentee bids are placed by telephone they are accepted at the Buyer's risk, and must be confirmed prior to the sale by letter or facsimile.
- ii. All absentee bids shall be registered with The CWA in accordance with The CWA's procedures and requirements. The CWA reserves its rights, at its sole and absolute discretion, to receive and/or reject such absentee bids and/or to receive and/or reject absentee bids if not registered. Absentee bidders must register his/her identity as per clause 10.a above.

4. Telephone Bids

- i. Subject to a Buyer arranging with The CWA and subject to a Buyer completing such documentation as The CWA may require it to do, whether it be by fax or by electronic transmission, or any other form of transmission, a Buyer, on making such telephone call, is deemed to accept these Terms and Conditions and to be bound thereby and shall be permitted to bid by means of a telecommunication. The right of a Buyer to bid is subject to a telecommunication line being available, fully functional and operative. The person who makes the bid on the telephone shall be deemed to be the Buyer and shall be deemed to be personally liable for the payment of the purchase

price and other amounts as are required to be paid. In executing bids on the telephone, the Buyer waives and abandons any claim howsoever or whatsoever arising against The CWA and/or the Auctioneer, including any act or omission and/or act of negligence and/or any act on the part of The CWA and the Auctioneer, or in failing to have regard or failing to take cognisance of such bid.

ii. The CWA reserves its rights, at its sole and absolute discretion, to receive and/or reject such telephone bids and/or to receive and/or reject telephone bids if given less than twenty-four hours before the auction and/or private treaty sales.

iii. The CWA reserves the right to record telephone bidding and the telephone bidder consents to such recording.

5. Payment

i. The hammer price as defined in clause A.1.x above, including further amounts payable in terms hereof such as Value Added Tax (if any), shall forthwith become due, owing and payable to The CWA in full immediately upon the knock down of the hammer and/or acceptance of the offer.

ii. Any payment by a Buyer to The CWA shall be applied by The CWA towards any sums owing by the Buyer to The CWA on any account whatever without regard to any directions of the Buyer or his/her agent, whether express or implied.

iii. The purchase price shall be paid in South African Rands. Foreign Buyers are required to make arrangements with their banking houses to transfer forex funds equivalent to the Rand value as stated on the purchase tax invoice. All fees relating to this transfer of funds from the foreign bank to The CWA's South African account shall be for the account of the Buyer.

iv. The CWA accepts only EFT's (electronic funds transfers) and Credit Card payments. No cheque payment or cash payments will be accepted.

6. Credit terms and Invoicing

- i. No credit shall be given to any Buyer unless prior to the auction The CWA has in its absolute discretion agreed in writing in response to a request to grant the Buyer credit. The Buyer shall make payment of such amounts of interest and other charges as are permitted in terms of the National Credit Act 34 of 2005. Ownership of the goods sold shall not vest and/or pass to the Buyer until such time as the full purchase price including VAT (if applicable) thereon and any other amounts have been paid in full.

ii. Buyers will be invoiced within 72hrs of Auction and have 30 days in which to make payment in full, but no lot may be collected/ redeemed until such time as there has been full and final payment as confirmed by The CWA. Any amounts outstanding will attract interest at 2% above the ruling South African prime interest rate

iii. Any auction lots unpaid 90 days after billing will automatically attract a 10% surcharge on the amount outstanding and be subject to legal proceedings being instituted by the CWA for collection of outstanding monies.

7. Collection of goods

i. Ownership of the goods purchased by a Buyer shall remain vested in The CWA, until such time as the Buyer has made full payment to The CWA which payment includes the payment of the purchase price of the goods, The Auctioneer's commission (if applicable), Value Added Tax on the sale (if applicable) and any other amounts as provided for herein.

ii. The Buyer will be responsible for all packing, removal, insurance, transport and storage charges.

iii. The Buyer will be responsible for the collection of the goods as per prior arrangement with the donor of the goods and only upon receipt of proof of payment that such goods have been paid for. Such proof of payment shall be obtained from The CWA.

8. The Buyer's Risk

i. The Buyer shall be solely responsible for any loss of and/or damage to and/or diminution in value of and/or deterioration of any goods (lots) purchased at the auction immediately upon the knock down by the Auctioneer to the Buyer of the hammer price.

9. Breach by the Buyer

i. Should the Buyer breach any of the terms and conditions thereof, alternatively not make payment in full or collect the items bought as provided herein, or should there be any other breach, the Auctioneer, agent for the Seller (alternatively The CWA in the event of it being the Seller of its own goods) will, and at its absolute and sole discretion, and without prejudice to any other rights it may have in law, be entitled to exercise one or more or all of the following remedies:

i. to institute proceedings against the Buyer for payment and/or damages for breach of contract;

ii. to cancel the sale of that or any other lots sold to the defaulting Buyer at the same time or at any other auction;

iii. to remove, store and insure the goods at the sole expense of the defaulting Buyer and if such goods are stored either at The CWA's premises or any other place as The CWA may require such goods to be stored at, the Buyer shall be responsible for all charges associated therewith;

iv. to charge interest on such monies as are due, owing and payable.
